1. Consumer Right Centre

- ▣ Centre undertakes research on various problems faced by consumers. The centre has helped BSLSA to prepare pamphlets which covers all the beneficial information needed by a consumer.
- ▣ Centre organised a consumer protection drive with the help of Legal Metrology Department, Government of Bihar.

- ▣ *Legal Awareness Programme for Women of Self Help Groups* in Begusarai on 12th September 2015.
- ▣ Organized one day *Legal Aid Programme* at Sewa Sadan, Muzaffarpur for the youth on 5th November 2015.

2. Centre for Client Counseling

- ▣ For client counseling, some trained senior students make themselves available at Academic Block-I, from 3 PM – 5 PM on every Wednesday and Friday. Students advice clients as per his/her needs. Students also make briefs of such cases and then consult with expert faculty for the same.
- ▣ PLV is helped by the students to prepare the documents.
- ▣ Cases are then referred to the Panel Advocate.

3. Centre for Legal Awareness Camps

- ▣ Members of LAC, go to various rural areas for spreading legal awareness among villagers.
- ▣ In these camps students present the legal provisions through street play, etc.
- ▣ In such camps commonly covered provisions are Right to Information, Right to Service, Consumer rights, Rights of arrested person, etc.
- ▣ Apart from these provisions some specific provisions as per necessity are also covered.
